A Prayer Hub is an internet based information and communications service for the benefit of praying people, the church and Christian organisations and agencies based in the British Isles and Ireland.

It will provide access to local, national and international Christian interest news, information, prayer needs and resources.

The service is to be delivered through a website that uses state of the art, powerful computers in the background capable of processing huge amounts of information at any given time.

The prayerhub.info brand name will be used to identify the service as a trusted information source.

What does it aim to do?

 - Instruct** - people by providing resources for those who want to develop their prayer life.
 - Inspire** - people with biblical teaching & real life stories of answers to prayer.

We provide the rails for the various trains to carry their information.

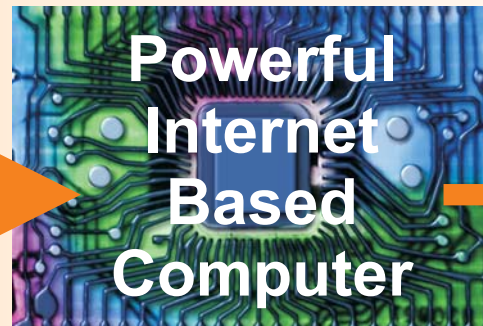
How will it work?
